C905 was defined as an area of high material concentration, possibly pit or dumb pit with stores, pottery, shells and animal bones covered with lots of sediment. On 15/07/24 we tried to explore C905's limits, to see if it is a pit but we couldn't find any clear limits or cuts, so we suspect that it could be a destruction layer. We also suspect that it could be an extension to the wall (C907 cause some holes (if not animal) align but this needs more investigation. We removed the material. Lots of pottery, mostly LN II. We also found an almost whole pot (jug: 7.5cm height, 3cm width) from LN II - black on red. Height: 7.5cm. Base: 3cm. Maximum body diameter: 8.5cm. Lots of sediment. Soil sample was collected 16/07/24: C905 was removed and the area of C908 expanded
