During removal of 902 and in the NW corner we uncovered a very large ^{mudbrick} ~~clay~~ very compact and firm (length: 27cm, width: 14cm, height: 13cm) so we followed it and uncovered a wall extending ~~towards~~ NW towards 903 (oven?). There are lots of holes, some possibly animal that circle the structure. On 17/07/24 we uncovered and defined the southern extension of the wall and realized that it has a semi-circular shape that extended from N to S side of the trench.
