This ^{context} layer concerns the cleaning of the bottom of the top layer (C900). On the northern side there was a large quantity of CBM with imprints of organic material, as a destruction layer. On the southern side there was CBM mixed with the dark brown soil. There was was a significant amount of pottery, animal bones and shells, as well as special finds like 2 spindle wheels (1 whole and 1 broken), chipped stone & ground stone. Observation: we noticed the pottery from this context was similar to C400 from Sector H3-B2 ^(note) because the context both the surfaces in both sectors that were in touch with the ground on both sectors were covered with sediments.
