It's the deposit we want to remove to reach the house floor. We excavated it as two artificial layers. In the first artificial layer we still can find porcelain and glass which means it's still

disturbed. In this second artificial layer we found a surface with a ashy, powdery soil which is the same as the one we defined as the house floor. The more we excavate to the south,

the more the findings get bigger and so the quantity especially the animal bone. There might be a pit around south west corner, we haven't defined its limits. According to the bone specialist, the bones we found there are all the end of the limbs, with many different species. The discussion of the

For the eastern side of the trench, we only excavate southern and west side. Eastern part to reach the house floor layer so be equal as the west side.

We found many chipped stone on the south east, and one whitish circular feature at Northern part. Its context 244. It's unexcavated.
