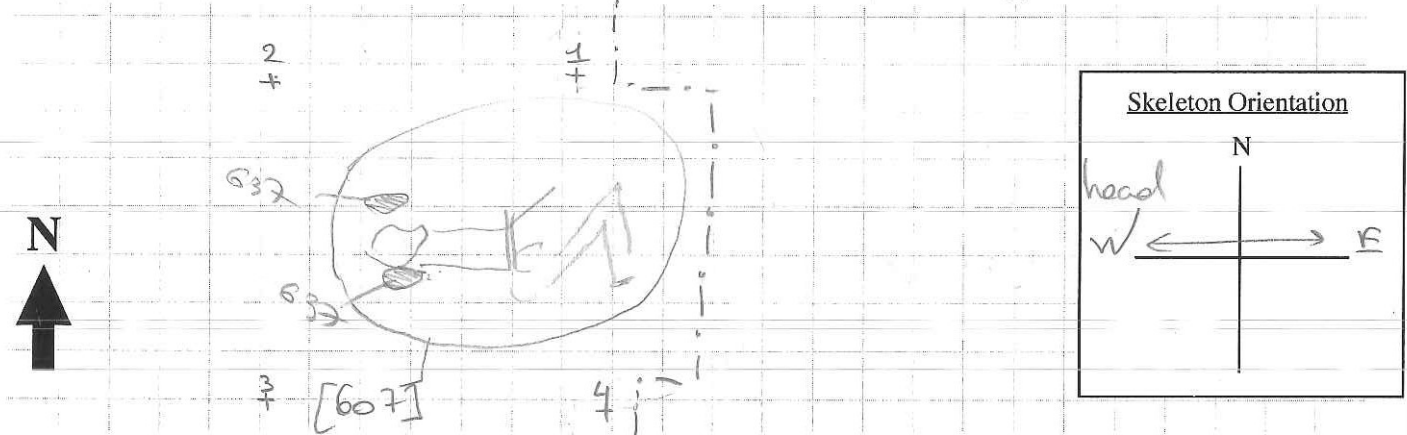

The burial belongs to a young adult in flexed position on its left side. Its left arm lay along his body in semi-flexed position whereas its right arm is bent at 90° angle crossing the stomach. The legs are flexed and the right foot is a natural position. Some linear effect have been noticed especially against the right upper limb. The head was bounded by two stones (637). No finds clearly associated with the skeleton but shells and a flint found near the neck and the right shoulder. Recorded individually in the fill 619.
